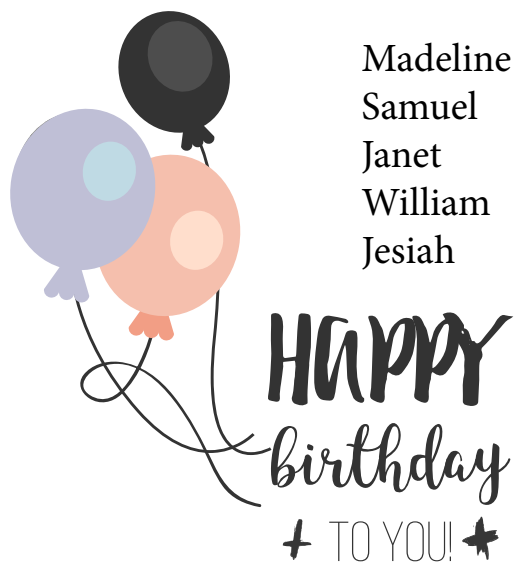
Helpers for Blastoff: Can you help lead Sunday School? We are looking for two more teams of two people. Helpers require a Blue Card and undertake the Uniting Church Safe Ministry Training. The Uniting Church Assembly has recently decided to allow for Ministers and Church Councils to perform same gender marriages. Copies of the Assembly Presidents statement can be found with the news sheets. In time the Church Council will consider the congregations perspectives on this matter in discussion with the new minister.

Ministry Transition: The Church Council is responsible for compiling a profile which, when approved by the Presbytery, will be sent to the Synod Placements Committee to explore available ministers who may be suitable for Sherwood. The congregation will call a Joint Nominating Committee (JNC) who will be in confidential conversation with potential ministers to discern if they will issue a call.

During the time of Transition, Rev Dr David Mackay-Rankin, will be our supply minister.

Community Conversation – Current Issues relating to our First Nations’s people as well all Australians’. We have been kindly supported by Brisbane City Council to have two community conversations, one on Saturday 10th November 2-4.30pm which will be held at the Pamphlett-Tennyson Seascouts near the Simpsons playground at the end of Graceville Avenue. The other conversation will take place in March 2019 – time to be confirmed at a later date.
